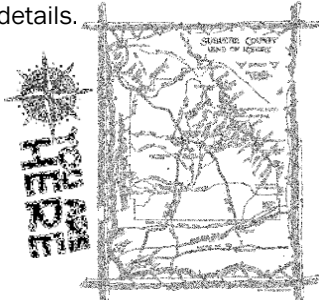


You Are Here: Sublette County

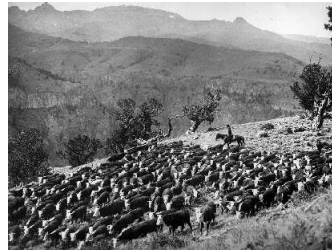
Summer Reading Challenge:

Life in Wyoming Captured on Film

During the month of July, stop in to see *Photographers of Wyoming*, a traveling exhibit from the University of Wyoming's American Heritage Center.

Like many before them, early photographers such as C.D. Kirkland, J.E. Stimson, and Charles J. Belden created and successfully marketed images of a mythic West. Setting their photographs against a backdrop of spectacular scenery, they intentionally emphasized the more romantic aspects of ranching and cowboy life. All three were master photographers, and like good artists they used their work to tell a story. Their photographs provide a valuable historic record of ranching and life in Wyoming.
